*CEF's Traditional Scholarship Program was established in 1997; the Tax Credit Scholarship is a separate initiative.

Tax Credit Program Overview:

The Kansas Legislature enacted the program in January 2015.

Purpose:

Provide qualified low-income families with the opportunity to choose a private education that they may not otherwise be able to afford.

Eligible Donors:

All Kansas taxpayers (corporate, privilege, premium and individual tax payers).
Individuals became eligible effective July 1.

How it Works:

Eligible donors contribute to CEF-SGO.

Donors receive a tax credit against their KS tax liability.



70% Tax Credit



in tax credits available in 2017.

(First-Come First-Serve)

The credits roll over and do not expire. Non-transferable.

CEF-SGO funds Tax Credit Scholarships to eligible students to cover a portion of tuition, fees and expenses.

Donors should consult their Tax Professionals to discuss their specific tax situation.

CEF is a 501(c)(3) Organization

CEF-SGO requested minimum individual contribution: \$10,000

Per the Legislation, the maximum contribution is \$500,000 per donor/year.

The CEF-SGO processes the contribution application with the KS Dept. of Revenue on behalf of the donor. Once approved, CEF sends the Tax Credit Certificate to the donor.
